

Flu Vaccination- The Dept of Health have announced that children in school years FS to four will be offered a flu vaccination this term. The flu vaccine for children is given as a single dose of nasal spray squirted up each nostril. Not only is it needle-free (a big advantage for children), the nasal spray works even better than the injected flu vaccine.

It's quick and painless and will mean your child is less likely to become ill if they come into contact with the flu virus.

A consent form will be sent home on Monday and needs to be returned to school by Thursday 16th November 2017.
